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THE POWER OF A VOW

“ SHE MADE A VOW, SAYING, ‘O LORD OF HOSTS, IF YOU WILL INDEED LOOK ON THE AFFLICTION (SUFFERING) OF YOUR MAIDSERVANT AND REMEMBER, AND NOT FORGET YOUR MAIDSERVANT, BUT WILL GIVE YOUR MAIDSERVANT A SON, THEN I WILL GIVE HIM TO THE LORD ALL THE DAYS OF HIS LIFE...’ ”

A LIVING SACRIFICE

“THEREFORE I URGE YOU, BROTHERS AND SISTERS, BY THE MERCIES OF GOD, TO PRESENT YOUR BODIES [DEDICATING ALL OF YOURSELVES, SET APART] AS A LIVING SACRIFICE, HOLY AND WELL-PLEASING TO GOD, WHICH IS YOUR RATIONAL (LOGICAL, INTELLIGENT) ACT OF WORSHIP”
ROMANS 12:1



Sacrifice is something that hurts. It isn't something easily done, and many are unable to do it. For it takes people of faith and determination to fully sacrifice. When we love the Lord truly, we understand that our bodies belong to Him. Thus, we live for Him daily. We don't do what we

desire but what His Word tells us. We live in obedience to the Word of God. It may sound easy, but in order to live according to the Word of God, it takes sacrifice, daily sacrifice. When we become a living sacrifice, His power begins living in us and is expressed through us.

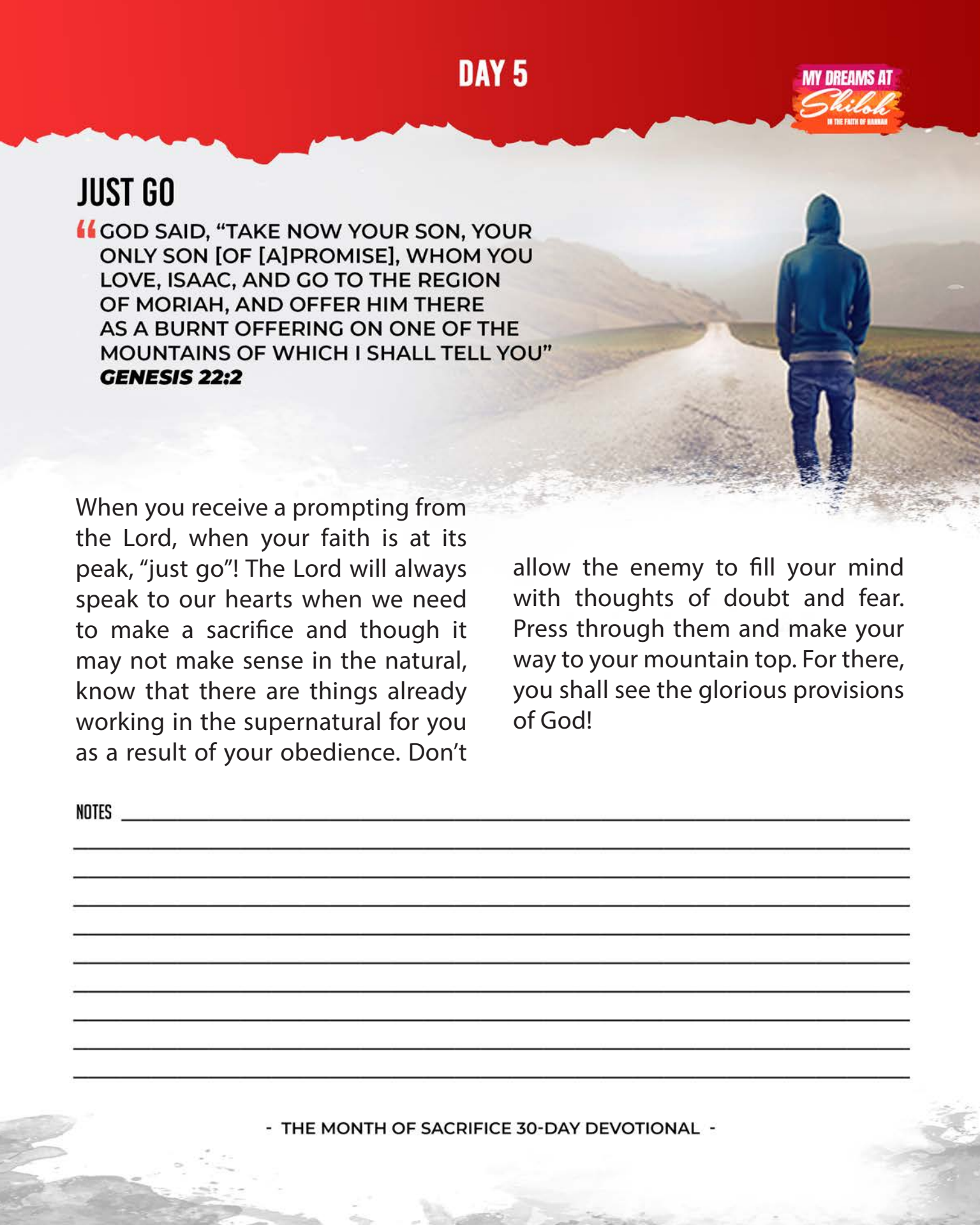
JUST GO

Many think there is weakness in serving another. I beg to differ. Servitude is a great act of love, and it calls for sacrifice. In today’s society, not many are willing to serve another. There are so many people who live so proudly and refuse to serve another

person. Jesus, our Lord, came and served the least. Let that sink in. Servitude calls for sacrifice, yet it is a sacrifice that fulfills the server, for what you do for yourself will die with you, but what you do for others will outlive you.

HUMILITY

“MY [ONLY] SACRIFICE [ACCEPTABLE] TO GOD IS A BROKEN SPIRIT; A BROKEN AND CONTRITE HEART [BROKEN WITH SORROW FOR SIN, THOROUGHLY PENITENT], SUCH, O GOD, YOU WILL NOT DESPISE”
PSALM 51:17



There is nothing more beautiful than humility. When we are humble, we understand fully that it is God in us and through us and not that of ourselves. This in itself is sacrificial. Anyone can be proud, but it takes sacrifice of self to be humble.

When we come before the Lord in humbleness, He will always be ready to listen and answer the requests of our heart.

THE LOVE WALK

**“THEREFORE BE IMITATORS OF GOD AS DEAR CHILDREN. AND WALK IN LOVE, AS CHRIST ALSO HAS LOVED US AND GIVEN HIMSELF FOR US, AN OFFERING AND A SACRIFICE TO GOD FOR A SWEET-SMELLING AROMA”
*EPHESIANS 5:1-2 NKJV***



Let's be real. It's not easy to love people, especially those difficult, unlovable people. Nevertheless, we are called to sacrificially love, thus becoming imitators of God! We are called to walk in love continually (that means when we feel like it and when we don't). We need to press our way through how we feel and do

what we know we need to do: LOVE SACRIFICIALLY. The love walk isn't for the faint of heart or for those who are led by emotions. It is for those who walk by faith and not by feelings. Though it's hard, it is possible.

SACRIFICING SELF

**“I HAVE BEEN CRUCIFIED WITH CHRIST; IT IS NO LONGER I WHO LIVE, BUT CHRIST LIVES IN ME; AND THE LIFE WHICH I NOW LIVE IN THE FLESH I LIVE BY FAITH IN THE SON OF GOD, WHO LOVED ME AND GAVE HIMSELF FOR ME”
*GALATIANS 2:20 NKJV***



There is no greater sacrifice than the sacrifice of the flesh and its desires. We, who have accepted Christ into our lives, must be willing to sacrifice self daily. Self and all of its fleshly desires cannot go before the Lord’s will. He now lives in us. His Holy Spirit abides in our hearts, and when we open our hearts to hear His Voice, we will begin to live by faith,

trusting in God to see us through any and all circumstances of life! Our flesh will shout, scream, and have a fit, but nevertheless, put it into full submission to God’s Word, and you’ll see the manifestation of great things in your life!

KEEPING OUR WORD

“BUT [AS FOR ME], I WILL SACRIFICE TO YOU WITH THE VOICE OF THANKSGIVING; I SHALL PAY THAT WHICH I HAVE VOWED. SALVATION IS FROM THE LORD!”

JONAH 2:9



We must understand that whatever we vow, we have vowed it to the Lord and not to man. Therefore, it is with Him that we are in agreement. When we vow anything unto the Lord, He takes it seriously, and He waits. Yes, He waits to see if we will

actually fulfill the vow or not. It's easy to promise something verbally, but the passing of the test and the graduation ceremony are for those who actually fulfill what they promised! God is faithful to those who are faithful.

NOTES

IF IT DOESN'T COST YOU, IT ISN'T A SACRIFICE

“BUT THE KING SAID TO ARAUNAH, ‘NO, BUT I WILL CERTAINLY BUY IT FROM YOU FOR A PRICE. I WILL NOT OFFER BURNT OFFERINGS TO THE LORD MY GOD WHICH COST ME NOTHING.’ SO DAVID PURCHASED THE THRESHING FLOOR AND THE OXEN FOR FIFTY SHEKELS OF SILVER”
2 SAMUEL 24:24

Listen up! Sacrifice costs us. If we don't feel the pain of what we're doing, then it isn't a sacrifice at all. It really is that simple! Sacrifice costs! David understood sacrifice, and he knew God. He wanted to offer unto the Lord sacrifices, and it was nice of Araunah to offer so willingly to help

David out. But sacrifice is personal, and David knew this. It had to come from him, from his resources, from his heart, from his sweat. When we fully understand this and do it, great results follow. Sacrifice costs.

NOTES _____

TAKE UP YOUR CROSS

“AND HE WAS SAYING TO THEM ALL, ‘IF ANYONE WISHES TO FOLLOW ME [AS MY DISCIPLE], HE MUST DENY HIMSELF [SET ASIDE SELFISH INTERESTS], AND TAKE UP HIS CROSS DAILY [EXPRESSING A WILLINGNESS TO ENDURE WHATEVER MAY COME] AND FOLLOW ME [BELIEVING IN ME, CONFORMING TO MY EXAMPLE IN LIVING AND, IF NEED BE, SUFFERING OR PERHAPS DYING BECAUSE OF FAITH IN ME]’ ”

LUKE 9:23



To take up our cross daily is no easy task. It calls for nothing less than sacrifice. When our flesh wants to get someone back for what he/she did, sacrifice says, “leave it alone.” When we want to give others a piece of our mind, sacrifice says, “Walk away.” Does our flesh want

this? No way! But if we desire to be like Christ, we must be willing to take up our cross and follow Him. To take up our cross is to be willing to sacrifice our own understanding when we’ve been wronged and wait on God for His justice.

CLEAN SACRIFICE

“AND NOAH BUILT AN ALTAR TO THE LORD, AND TOOK OF EVERY [CEREMONIALLY] CLEAN ANIMAL AND OF EVERY CLEAN BIRD AND OFFERED BURNT OFFERINGS ON THE ALTAR”

GENESIS 8:20



When we do anything for the Lord, we must do it with a clean heart. The Lord delights in sacrifices that are derived from a clean and surrendered heart. The Lord looks at the heart and sees the motive behind the giving. When

our motive is right, the aroma will be right, and the answer will be right on its way! The Lord is faithful to those who are faithful, and all those who sacrifice from a clean heart will call the attention of God.

GET UP EARLY AND SPEAK UP

“THEN THE LORD SAID TO MOSES, RISE EARLY IN THE MORNING AND STAND BEFORE PHARAOH, AND SAY TO HIM, THUS SAYS THE LORD GOD OF THE HEBREWS: LET MY PEOPLE GO, THAT THEY MAY SERVE ME”
EXODUS 9:13 NKJV

When we're in a battle, it calls for strength, courage, and much sacrifice. Sometimes, we just have to get up early in the morning and address the problem that is before us! Speak to the problem rather than about it. The more you speak about it, the stronger it becomes. But the more you address it, the weaker it becomes. It takes sacrifice to step out of our comfort zone and walk into the

battle and fight. It's so much easier to have someone else fight for us, pray for us, fast for us. But remember, it's those who fight who will receive the victory of the battle and not the bystanders. It's the one who speaks that gets heard.

USE WHAT YOU'VE GOT

“AND THE LORD SAID TO HIM,
'WHAT IS THAT IN
YOUR HAND?'
AND HE SAID, 'A STAFF' ”
EXODUS 4:2



The LORD will never ask you to sacrifice what you don't have or what you cannot obtain. When it comes to sacrifice, it must come from YOU and not someone else. For if your sacrifice costs you nothing, it will bring you nothing. Sometimes, we think that what we have isn't enough, but in the Hands of God,

it's more than enough to call down plagues and open seas that are closed before our ways! Yes, look at your own life and search for what is indeed YOUR sacrifice and get ready to present it to the LORD and see His manifestation and great glory in YOUR life!

THE SACRIFICIAL COVERING

“THE BLOOD SHALL BE A SIGN FOR YOU ON [THE DOORPOSTS OF] THE HOUSES WHERE YOU LIVE; WHEN I SEE THE BLOOD I SHALL PASS OVER YOU, AND NO AFFLICTION SHALL HAPPEN TO YOU TO DESTROY YOU WHEN I STRIKE THE LAND OF EGYPT”

EXODUS 12:13

There is a covering over a sacrificial life that another life does not have. When a believer lives sacrificially in obedience to the Word of God, there is a “blood covering” that protects him/her from all harm! What blood covering is that? For the Israelites, it was the blood of a young goat or lamb placed on the doorposts

of their homes, but today, it is the precious Blood of Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God, placed over the doorposts of our hearts in ways that we’re not even aware of!

THE UNAVOIDABLE MATCH

“SO JACOB WAS LEFT ALONE, AND A MAN [CAME AND] WRESTLED WITH HIM UNTIL DAYBREAK”
GENESIS 32:24

Without a shadow of a doubt, this was a sacrifice for Jacob. He was already weary while traveling from Haran back to Canaan. He was running from his uncle Laban while trying to figure out how he was going to confront his brother Esau. Jacob’s family had grown large in number, and he quickly had to move them across the Jabbok brook. Nevertheless, this match could not be avoided. Through

much sacrifice, Jacob fought and won and received a new name: Israel. There are situations in life that we cannot avoid, and at times, we can become discouraged and exhausted. Nevertheless, if we stand upright and fight and depend on God’s strength, we will overcome.

THE WILDERNESS EXPERIENCE

“WHEN PHARAOH HEARD ABOUT THIS MATTER, HE TRIED TO KILL MOSES. THEN MOSES FLED FROM PHARAOH’S PRESENCE AND TOOK REFUGE IN THE LAND OF MIDIAN, WHERE HE SAT DOWN BY A WELL”
EXODUS 2:15

There is no escaping the wildernesses of life. Sooner or later, everybody will find themselves in a wilderness. It’s a place of desolation but not despair. It’s a place of sacrifice but also serenity. It is in the wilderness that God molds us and makes us who He desires us to be. Don’t run away from your wilderness; you just might

find yourself there longer than you have to be. Keep a good sacrificial attitude in the wilderness. Know that God is there with you, and He knows exactly what you need and how long you need to be there. Grow in your wilderness!

GROWING THROUGH OPPOSITION

“BUT THE MORE THE EGYPTIANS OPPRESSED THEM, THE MORE THEY MULTIPLIED AND EXPANDED, SO THAT THE EGYPTIANS DREADED AND WERE EXASPERATED BY THE ISRAELITES”
EXODUS 1:12



When a child of God has a purpose over his/her life, there is no sacrifice too big, much less any opposition too strong! A believer who sacrifices is a believer who knows what he/she is entitled to and will press through

any form of opposition and keeps bearing the fruit he/she is called to bear!

NOTES

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS

“YOU SHALL CONSTRUCT IT IN ACCORDANCE WITH EVERYTHING THAT I AM GOING TO SHOW YOU, AS THE PATTERN OF THE TABERNACLE AND THE PATTERN OF ALL ITS FURNITURE”
EXODUS 25:9



When God asks us to do something, He's very clear. From the material for the Tabernacle to its measurement, to the Ark of the Covenant, table of bread, the golden lampstand, and so on, God was absolutely clear. When we seek the Face of God for our life, He will show us things that we would

never have seen or understood if they had not come from Him. His instructions are clear, and He's expecting us to fulfill them.

REMAINING STILL

“MOSES WAS WILLING TO REMAIN WITH THE MAN, AND HE GAVE MOSES HIS DAUGHTER ZIPPORAH [TO BE HIS WIFE]”

EXODUS 2:21

Sometimes, the sacrifice may not be in going somewhere but in staying right where you are. How many are those who run from a problem rather than remain and try to fix it? Do you know why? It takes sacrifice to remain. It may take self-denial and maybe even a little humbling in order to remain. How willing are we to sacrifice and stay right

where God wants us to be? I can assure you that if we stay when God says “Stay,” we will reap the harvest of our sacrificial obedience.

TRUST BEFORE THE SEA OF TURMOIL

“AS PHARAOH APPROACHED, THE ISRAELITES LOOKED UP AND SAW THE EGYPTIANS MARCHING AFTER THEM, AND THEY WERE VERY FRIGHTENED; SO THE ISRAELITES CRIED OUT TO THE LORD”

EXODUS 14:10

How many times have we been before a sea of turmoil? It could be a sea of family problems that seem to be so huge and never-ending. Maybe we're before a sea of negative/fearful thoughts that seem to be drowning out good sense over and over again; no matter how much we try to keep our heads above the waters, we're constantly going down. SACRIFICE IS THE HIGHEST FORM OF WORSHIP

“AND GOD SAID, ‘CERTAINLY I WILL BE WITH YOU, AND THIS SHALL BE THE SIGN TO YOU THAT IT IS I WHO HAVE SENT YOU: WHEN YOU HAVE BROUGHT THE PEOPLE OUT OF EGYPT, YOU SHALL SERVE AND WORSHIP GOD AT THIS MOUNTAIN’ ”
EXODUS 3:12



There is no greater act of worship than sacrifice! Worship isn't songs sung on a Sunday morning nor neatly fit Biblical memorization To worship is to give up oneself and all one's desires to pick up God's

will and way. God desires true worshippers who worship the LORD in Spirit and in truth. One can never be a real worshipper if he/she is not willing to live sacrificially for the LORD.

AN EVERLASTING FIRE

“THE ANGEL OF THE LORD APPEARED TO HIM IN A BLAZING FLAME OF FIRE FROM THE MIDST OF A BUSH; AND HE LOOKED, AND BEHOLD, THE BUSH WAS ON FIRE, YET IT WAS NOT CONSUMED. SO MOSES SAID, ‘I MUST TURN AWAY [FROM THE FLOCK] AND SEE THIS GREAT SIGHT—WHY THE BUSH IS NOT BURNED UP’ ”

EXODUS 3:2-3



Our God is an everlasting Fire! He is a fire that can burn and bring to ashes all our troubles and sorrows. Those who understand the power of sacrifice also understand that a sacrifice is always positioned at a high place and ultimately burned. In other words, wherever there is a sincere sacrifice, God’s consuming

fire is present to receive it. Moses had to sacrificially leave the flock behind in order to get close to this awesome sight! And when he did, God spoke.

NOTES _____

STOP MAKING EXCUSES

“ THEN MOSES SAID TO THE LORD, ‘PLEASE, LORD, I AM NOT A MAN OF WORDS (ELOQUENT, FLUENT), NEITHER BEFORE NOR SINCE YOU HAVE SPOKEN TO YOUR SERVANT; FOR I AM SLOW OF SPEECH AND TONGUE’ ”

EXODUS 4:10

Let’s be real with ourselves; how often do we make excuses just to not do what God has asked us to do? Maybe, it might seem hard at the time, or maybe we just don’t want to do it, period. Either way, making excuses will only hinder our breakthrough. The question is: How badly do we want this testimony? How much are we willing to give up in order to receive? Our excuses can even sound really legit,

but God isn’t interested in our excuses. He wants willingness to sacrifice what He’s commanding us to sacrifice. If it’s our ego, sacrifice it. If it’s our fear, sacrifice it. Is it our pride? Sacrifice it. If it’s a monetary amount that God has nudged your heart to offer to Him, sacrifice it. Stop making excuses!

NOTES

THE LORD'S PROVISION ACCOMPANIES OUR OBEDIENCE

“ THEN HE CRIED TO THE LORD [FOR HELP], AND THE LORD SHOWED HIM A TREE, [A BRANCH OF] WHICH HE THREW INTO THE WATERS, AND THE WATERS BECAME SWEET. THERE THE LORD MADE A STATUTE AND AN ORDINANCE FOR THEM, AND THERE HE TESTED THEM”

EXODUS 15:25

God will always provide for those who sacrifice to Him. But at times, He will ask us to do something before He performs the miracle. You see, this is called collaboration. When we collaborate with God by doing our part, He comes through and does His. What is our part usually? It's sacrificial prayer/fasting, forgiving,

loving, obeying, etc. Sometimes, God will ask us to do something in order to see just how much we're trusting in His command. If we obey, we're showing Him that we believe and we trust; thus, in return, He honors and provides the answer!

NOTES _____

YOUR MILK AND HONEY

“SO I HAVE COME DOWN TO RESCUE THEM FROM THE HAND (POWER) OF THE EGYPTIANS, AND TO BRING THEM UP FROM THAT LAND TO A LAND [THAT IS] GOOD AND SPACIOUS, TO A LAND FLOWING WITH MILK AND HONEY [A LAND OF PLENTY]—TO THE PLACE OF THE CANAANITE, THE HITTITE, THE AMORITE, THE PERIZZITE, THE HIVITE, AND THE JEBUSITE”

EXODUS 3:8

The land the LORD had for His people was a good land, one that flowed with milk and honey, nothing lacking at all. Did you know that there is a promised land for you? Yes, YOU! God has a testimony with your name on it. God has a breakthrough for you. Just as the Israelites cried out, we also must cry out. Get out of

our comfort zones and comfy beds at the midnight hour and sacrificially seek Him and His Hand in our lives. We need to strive to receive that milk and honey that the LORD has for us and let nothing and no one stop us from reaching our promised land.

NOTES

A COVENANT-KEEPING GOD

“SO GOD HEARD THEIR GROANING AND GOD REMEMBERED HIS COVENANT WITH ABRAHAM, ISAAC, AND JACOB (ISRAEL)”
EXODUS 2:24

God is a covenant-keeping God. We have been brought into a covenant with God through the finished work of the cross, through the Blood of Jesus! Know that God is faithful to His promise. His Word can never and will never return to Him void. It must accomplish what it was sent

out to do. When we do our part, He certainly does His.

NOTES _____

A HUNDRED-FOLD REWARD

“THE OVERLAPPING PART THAT IS LEFT OVER FROM THE TENT CURTAINS, THE HALF CURTAIN THAT IS LEFT OVER, SHALL LAP OVER THE BACK OF THE TABERNACLE”
EXODUS 26:12

There is a hundredfold reward for all those who plant sacrificially and believe God for the increase. Hallelujah! A harvest awaits us when we trust in the LORD, even in times of drought, for we have understood the power of sacrificial planting. Letting go of our seed brings forth our harvest. We cannot have a

harvest if we don't let go of the seed. If God did it for Isaac, He will do it for you. Take hold of your seed and look at it well. Will that seed do anything for you in your hand? If you know that it won't (and you know that it won't), sow it. A hundredfold reward will follow.
